Parking Permits for campus parking

In order to park in parking lots or garages on campus without getting a ticket, you must buy a parking permit. Parking permit options are outlined below:

- **"C" Permits**

Any registered student whose local place of residence is outside an area at least 1.5 miles from campus may purchase a "C" permit for \$100 per year. The 1.5 mile boundary is defined as an area bounded by Airport Road, McCormick Road, Cherry Lane, Northwestern Avenue, Ridgewood Drive, Forest Hill Drive, Salisbury Street, Kingston Drive, Rose Street, Lincoln Street extended to the Wabash River, the Wabash River and the railroad tracks bordering the south edge of campus. If you have any questions concerning a specific address, please contact Parking Facilities. "C" permits may be purchased online at www.purdue.edu/parking or at the Parking Facilities Office. Students must provide proof of their local address and a photo ID.

- **"A" Permits**

Students employed by Purdue at least 30 hours per week are eligible to purchase an "A" permit for \$250 per year or a "B" permit for \$100 per year. A form is available at Parking Facilities.

- **Disability Parking**

Students may apply for disability parking through the Parking Facilities Office, located at 700 Ahlers Dr, West Lafayette, IN 47907. Office hours are 7:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Mon.- Fri.

- **University Housing Permits**

The sale of residence hall permits must be purchased online through the Parking Facilities website, www.purdue.edu/parking. If you choose to pick-up your permit, a photo ID is required for pick-up.

CityBus

CityBus offers free rides for Purdue students, faculty, staff and retirees with a valid Purdue photo ID. Free rides are available on all Campus Loop and regular route buses operated by CityBus throughout Lafayette and West Lafayette. Keep in mind as you search for housing that many graduate students take classes or work in their labs at night and many bus routes do not run at night. If you are planning to stay in the area during the summer, be sure to check the summer bus schedules as some campus routes do not run as frequently or at all during the summer.
